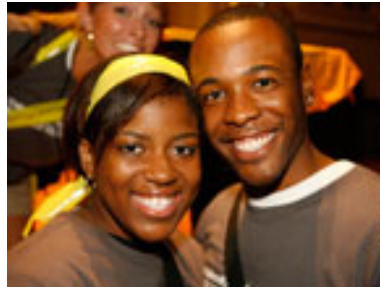





Use the left-hand navigation pane to select any section of the bulletin, including degree programs, courses, and specific colleges.



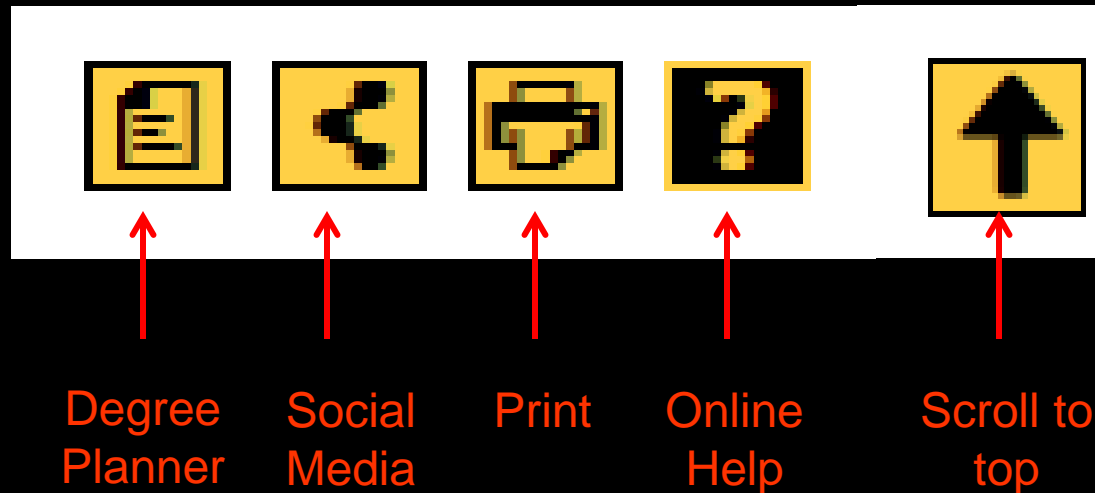

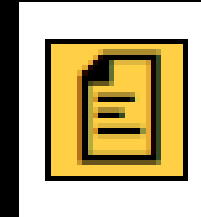
